Tim White has an extensive and varied career in live performance, film and television. Initially he worked in group-devised community theatre at Gorman House, Canberra. In Perth in the mid 80's, he was a founding member and artistic director of The Performance Group.

Changing direction in the late 80's Tim moved into stand-up comedy, founding the Lismore Comedy Cafe as a performer and show producer.

He also produced his own one man show, *White Lies*, and performed at comedy venues such as the Greyhound Hotel, in Sydney and Melbourne's own Gershwin Room at the Esplanande Hotel, as well as at Trades Hall.

He continued running the Lismore Comedy Cafe on a regular basis for eight years before coproducing *Top Blokes* which successfully toured New South Wales as well as appearing at the Melbourne International Comedy Festival.

Tim has an ongoing commitment to theatre training and education and undertook an arts degree majoring in Theatre Studies at the University of New England in 2000 – 2002 where he was awarded the inaugural theatre department prize for high achievement. He moved to Melbourne in 2003 to complete an honours degree in Performance Studies at Monash University, receiving a first class honours.

From 2006 to 2009Tim worked as a high school media, drama and english teacher.

Between 2006 – 2008 he was also active in student film making and performed in a number of short films while completing a Masters of Film and Television Production at RMIT, graduating from the program in 2009. During this time he also co-founded a Feet Mermaid Films, working as a producer and presenter on a number of films including a documentary commissioned by the Federal Attorney General's Department and Darebin City Council.

In 2010 Tim was invited to direct the dance-theatre piece *Iris*, which was recognised with a Highly Commended Certificate from the Fringe Festival.
